We offer four distinct scholarship categories, each designed to support different profiles of students who are ready to make a difference in the world.

1. Merit-Based International Scholarship. Up to 30%

Overview:

For international students who have consistently demonstrated outstanding academic performance and a deep commitment to learning.

Requirements:

- Minimum GPA of 3.4/4.0 or equivalent.
- Transcripts translated into English or Spanish.
- Academic letter of recommendation.
- Proof of language proficiency

Essay Prompt:

Suggested Title: "Knowledge as a Catalyst for Change"

Length: 400–500 words

Explain how your academic achievements reflect your commitment to learning and how you plan to use your knowledge to create a positive impact in your field or community.

2. Diversity & Inclusion Scholarship – Up to 25%

Overview:

This scholarship is intended for students who bring valuable perspectives shaped by their unique cultural, personal, or geographical backgrounds. It aims to foster an inclusive, globally diverse academic community where different voices and stories are recognized and celebrated.

Requirements:

Essay Prompt:

Suggested Title: “My Identity as a Bridge for Understanding”

Length: 250–400 words

Reflect on how your personal journey has influenced your identity and perspective. Share how you believe your presence and participation will help enrich the learning experience for your peers in an international, multicultural environment.

3. Global Entrepreneur Scholarship. Up to 35%

Overview:

For students with an entrepreneurial spirit and innovative projects or business ideas that aim to make a social, economic, or environmental impact.

Requirements:

- Previous entrepreneurial experience (preferred but not required).
- Letter of recommendation from a mentor, teacher, or collaborator affirming your potential as an entrepreneur and your ability to lead innovative initiatives

Essay Prompt:

Suggested Title: “Innovation for Impact: My Entrepreneurial Journey”

Length: 400–500 words

Describe your entrepreneurial experience, what you’ve learned, the impact you aim to achieve, and how the scholarship will help you grow or launch your project.

4. Future Leaders Scholarship. Up to 25%

Overview:

For young changemakers who have taken on leadership roles in their schools, communities, or through social initiatives, and who demonstrate responsibility, vision, and the power to inspire others.

Essay Prompt:

Suggested Title: "To Lead is to Serve: My Commitment to Change"

Length: 250-500 words

Talk about your leadership journey, the challenges you've faced, what you've learned, and how you intend to keep creating positive change in the future.

Important Scholarship Conditions

- **Scholarships are not cumulative. Applicants may only receive one scholarship from the IVAEN Education Foundation, and it cannot be combined with another Foundation scholarship.**
- **However, scholarships can be combined with other institutional discounts,* such as early payment or one-time payment incentives, allowing candidates to maximize financial benefits.**
- **Application process: All scholarship applications and supporting documents must be submitted through your assigned Admissions Personal Advisor.**
- **Notification timeline: Scholarship decisions will be communicated either:**
 - **Along with your admission offer, or**
 - **Within a maximum of 48 hours after submitting your complete scholarship application, whichever comes first.**
- **To activate and secure the scholarship, admitted candidates must:**
 - **Pay the deposit for the selected program. This deposit must be no less than 25% of the remaining tuition fee, after deducting the scholarship amount.**
 - **Settle all non refundable registration and administrative fees within 7 to 10 days of receiving the scholarship decision.**

Failure to meet these deadlines will result in the release of the allocated scholarship funds, which may then be awarded to another eligible candidate.
